

Thank you for registering your child for lessons with our program. I am honored to be able to work with your child, encouraging a love for the water and teaching them the skills necessary to be safe in and around the water.

The skills your child will learn is a cumulative process. It is similar to putting together pieces of a puzzle. Each individual part of the sequence is taught and consists of many little pieces, and as a skill is mastered, the next skill is introduced, which builds upon what has previously been learned. It is extremely beneficial for your child to have a great first day of lessons, and as a parent, you play a big part in your child's success! ## REGISTRATION

The Swim Safe Now registration fee is valid for the current calendar year. The registration fee covers the cost of registration review and insurance requirements.

Students who return for maintenance or refresher lessons in the same calendar year may be required to update their registration information. Updating the registration will depend on the amount of time that has passed since the initial registration was completed and/or if there have been any illnesses, new medications, specialists. A registration update in the same calendar year will NOT require an additional registration fee. Safety is our #1 priority and we want to be sure that we have the latest information about your child to ensure they are in optimum health to participate and to provide a safe lesson.

## PAYMENTS

- ★ Lesson fees are \$100 per week for cash, \$105 per week for PayPal.
  - Lesson fees are due on Monday.
